

### Peter Pan's Press

We're really looking forward to the start of the new term and school year, and hope you're all enjoying the summer so far! A reminder that Monday 6th September is a stay and play session for the new starters only, from 10-11am, and then playschool resumes as normal for all children from Tuesday 7th.



We'll be continuing to welcome the children through the green room which is accessed half way down the ramp towards the main doors. We'll open the door at 9.10 and if you'll be arriving after 9.20 please do let us know so we can close the door and get the staff in the main room with the children as quickly as possible. The new starters may need a little time to settle, and you're very welcome to stay as long as you need, and returning children equally may feel a little unsettled to start with, so please don't feel under pressure to rush off if your child needs you to stay a few minutes.

Please don't forget to have a look at the Childcare Choices website in case you qualify for the 30 hours extended childcare if your child is 3 before the end of August and both parents work, or a lone parent works. If you miss the deadline of the end of August, you won't qualify until January and may be liable for additional fees if your child attends more than 15 hours www.childcarechoices.gov.uk For those children who are funded, we'll be handing out funding declaration forms in the first week of term and we'll need these returned as soon as possible.

Due to the changes in Government Covid measures, face coverings are no longer mandatory indoors, apart from when mixing in busy spaces. Staff may choose to wear face coverings at drop off and pick up time for their own peace of mind, and if we have several parents settling children at drop off, you may like to wear one yourself for added protection. We're really proud of the fact we haven't lost a day of playschool since we re-opened after lockdown 1, and this has been brought about by our robust risk assessments, enhanced hygiene and cleaning regimes as well staff and children staying home when they've been unwell in any way.

We are hoping to re-introduce the parent rota now restrictions are lifted, so please do let us know if you're able to pop in and help with the washing up/playing with the children - we'll wait until we're all settled back in before we formally re-introduce this and ask you to continue to follow the guidelines of not attending if you are unwell in any way.

New Starters: Please bring along proof of age (birth certificate or passport) for your child for the stay and play session or their first session so we can confirm their eligibility to register.

#### **Information**

We will continue to plan weekly themes around the children's interests and will share this in the weekly newsletters. When we first return, our loose theme will be settling into playschool and our families.

We will be displaying our family tree wall display, and it would be lovely to have all the children and their families represented on here – please either bring in or email a small photo of your child and their immediate family. They really enjoy showing us the photo's of their parents and siblings. If you speak any additional languages at home and would like us to support your child using any particular words, please do let us know as it all really helps with getting to know each other and settling in.

Garden - Please remember we use the garden every day, rain or shine, so please send your child with appropriate clothing and ideally a pair of wellies.

Please ensure your child brings a named water bottle each session, as well as a mid-morning snack - ideally some fruit or vegetables and some like to bring cheese and crackers too.
